EARNED INCOME (WAGE) TAX QUESTIONNAIRE

Background and Instructions

The information that you provide will determine the tax rate and jurisdiction for which your withholding will be remitted and/or earnings reported. Please enter the name of the county and city, borough or township of your residence and office. The municipality may be different from the post office location through which mail is delivered. You can verify the correct municipality information by entering http://munstats.pa.gov/public/ click on Taxes and then Find Municipality by Address.

The following order of priority will determine which tax rate is applicable:

- 1. *Philadelphia* If you are a resident of the City or a non-resident working in the City, the Philadelphia Wage Tax must, by law, must be withheld.
- 2. Residence Municipality If the municipality in which you reside levies a tax equal to or greater than the office municipal tax, the tax is withheld using the resident rate.
- 3. Office Municipality This is the municipality in which your office is located. If the office municipality levies a non-resident wage tax that is higher than your resident municipality tax, the tax is withheld using the non-resident rate from your office location.
